Fundraising hits the high notes

Did you know that over the past few years all the money raised by the PTFA goes directly to the school to help enrich the education of it's pupils?

The money raised from last year has been spent on trips and enrichment activities that have benefited all children. Each class is assigned £200 which they can use to enhance their curriculum plan whether this is through a trip or a visitor which ties in to the childrens learning.

The rest of the money, **£5,688** has gone towards improving the teaching and learning of music across the school in 2019/20. This includes the purchasing of new instruments, music lessons (practical and theory) for children in each year group and introduces children to music at an early age.

In 2019/20 we are aiming to raise £10k
